  - **Senior Grades** A, B, C, D Split comp of Men and Women

**NEW RULES** starting 2023 Spring competition.

- No more than 3 players from a higher grade/ Division can play together in a lower grade/ division.
- Clock will stop for all senior games (night comp) domestic games and finals timeouts, free throws and jump ball

### Grading/ Divisions

Team contacts will be required to nominate a Grade/ Division when registering a team.

To ensure equity in our competitions, nominations will be reviewed by the grading committee of our association, who may amend a nomination based on the teams playing group and experience.

No more than 3 players from a higher grade/ Division can play together in a lower grade/ division.

ALL individuals intending to play in our competitions must be registered with Basketball NSW and Tumut Basketball.

No player will be allowed to take the court under any circumstance prior to being registered. Registration can be paid online and will be received by the Association registrar.

Players can check registration by going to [member.basketball.net.au](http://member.basketball.net.au) and logging in with their Game Day email and password. Once logged in, they'll be able to

**New Members-** if you are registering for the first time, please **do not pay registration until you or the association have found you a team or can commit to the competition days/nights. No refunds will be given.** Once your allocated to a team and you have completed a membership form, agreed to the terms and conditions, and paid the relevant fees, your membership is valid for 12 months from the date of registration.

**An existing member renewing within 30 days** - If you renew your membership within 30-days of it expiring, your new expiry date is 12 months from the previous expiry date. **Do not pay registration until you or the association have found a team or you can commit to the competition days/nights. No refunds will be given.**

**An existing member who renews after 30 days** - if you renew your registration after 30-days of it expiring, your new expiry date is 12-months from the date you have completed a registration form, agreed to the terms and conditions, and paid the relevant membership fees. **Do not pay registration until you or the association have found a team, or you can commit to the competition days/nights. No refunds will be given.**

## Team Registration

**Teams must have a minimum of 5 players to submit a team nomination.**

Teams will be graded based on the ability of players within your team once team nominations have closed. Additions to teams can be made at any time during the competition. Prior to adding new players to a team, we require a completed add a player to team form, this form needs submitting to our committee for approval before players can commence taking the court. These forms can be found on our website or from the stadium. Please allow up to 7 days for approval.

Teams may bring up a player from the grade/division below.

Players must play a minimum of 4 games to qualify for the finals.

Players can play two grades/divisions. They must nominate in the lower grade/division team but also include their name on the higher grade/division on team sheets.

Secondary school children Under 18 years can play 3 grade/division if they would like. Prior approval is needed by the grading committee.

**For existing teams who are re-entering a competition** – Teams who have nominated online previously can use their existing team code and password to nominate a team. You still need to fill out a team nomination form and email to tumutbasketball@gmail.com **Your nomination will not be accepted until our registrar has received this form.**

Once you nominate, please also invite your team members to join your team using their email addresses. All team members must join teams via the online process prior to the start of the competition.

Please remind team mates **Not to pay registration until grading has been done and you are 100% sure you're in a team or can commit to the competition days/nights. No refunds will be given.** Please contact the registrar Trish Day 0427474768 should you face any difficulties in nominating your team.

**All new teams** – Will need to fill out a Team Registration Form and email it to tumutbasketball@gmail.com Once you have nominated a team, after grading has been done you will receive a Link to join the team and pay registration. Please remind team mates **Not to pay registration until grading has been done and you are 100% sure you're in a team or can commit to the competition days/nights.** Please contact the registrar Trish Day 0427474768 should you face any difficulties in nominating your team. **No refunds will be given.**

## Player Registration

All players must be in a team before paying registration.

NSW membership, Tumut memberships and participant fees are to be paid via the online process No later than 24 hours before the player is due to take the court. **Do not pay registration until Grading has been done and you are 100% sure you're in a team or can commit to the competition days/nights. No refunds will be given.**

All players need to be registered 24hrs before taking the court. If you haven't paid 24hrs before your due to take the court, you will not be allowed to play. Our online system takes 24hrs to update to the ipads.

## Duty- Bench/Scoring

All teams will require 2 capable bench scorers. If scorers are not allocated at the start of the game the team will be penalised.

Courtside scoring will be used from Round 1 of competitions. This is iPad based and replaces the scoresheet. Again, it is imperative that each team supply at least two people to do scoring duties for their game.

**Mini ball Grades-** require a parent from each team to do duty for their game.

## Duty- Referees

As a committee we try our best to cover all games with referees, but this isn't always possible, so we ask that each team has a capable referee allocated to cover their duty game.

## UNIFORM

Numbers on singlets should be on the front and back.

All team members must have the same dominant colour shorts/bottoms. Does not necessarily have to be the same as the singlet/top colour. Normal "out-of-uniform" penalties apply after Round 3.

## Forfeits

Forfeits can be made to Trish Day on 0427474768

A team that forfeits four (4) times in a Season is excluded from the competition.

- A team with prior knowledge of intent to a forfeit need to give notice to the Forfeit manager a minimum of Four (4) hours before scheduled game, ensuring minimal inconvenience.
- A team that receives a forfeit from another team will receive the two (2) competition points for a win.
- Un notified forfeits, no show or insufficient players (less than four (4) after ten (10) minutes past starting time will lose two (2) competition points.
- Appeals must be in writing to the Committee within 24 hours.
